Homebound Procedures for Special Education Teachers

- I. Students that receive special education services must have a reevaluation and a new IEP before homebound services can begin.

- II. The homebound IEP reflects on essential skills that the student must master. The may include but are not limited to E/LA and Math.

- III. If the special education teacher is the lead teacher for any of the subjects listed on the IEP, they must provide work for the student. If the student is in inclusion, the special education teacher MAY need to modify assignments before they are sent home.

- IV. An IEP must be held when the student returns to school. This IEP must contain a revised Behavior Plan.
