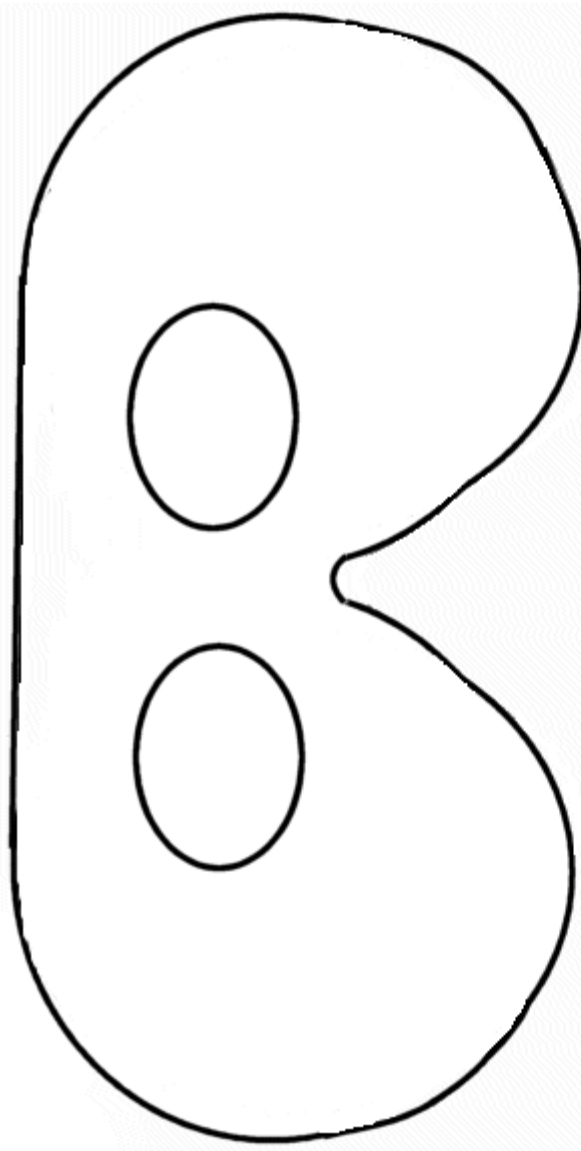


Child's Mask



1. Trace this template onto heavy construction paper, card stock, or a paper bag. Cut out. (Test the template for size on your child's before using it and adjust.)
2. Use whatever you want to decorate your mask.
3. Staple or glue pieces of yarn, ribbon, or string to the sides so that it can be tied at the back.

OPTIONS: You could staple one side of the mask to the top of a straw to make a mardi gras mask, or you could use a piece of elastic cording stapled to both sides instead of tying it at the back of the child's head.
