

Using United Streaming

First Time User:

1. Get your school's pass code. See page 2:
2. Type in the school pass code and then click "Sign Up"
3. You must fill out all required information.
4. Write down the user name and pass code that you choose

All users:

United Streaming

1. Type in your user name and password and click on enter. You will no longer need the school's pass code.
2. Once you have typed in your user name and password, you will be at the LPB Cyber-Channel, video-on-demand.

Searching:

There are several ways to search.

1. You can type in a keyword such as photosynthesis.
2. You can type in a keyword and choose a subject area and a grade level.
3. You can choose a subject and grade level and then choose a category. Once you have chosen a category, you can then choose a sub category.

Ex:/ Subject: Science
Grade Level: 4th
Category: Life Science /Biology
Sub Category: Birds

Click on the "Go" to search.

Search Results:

- Once you have done a search, the results of that search will appear. There should be several videos to choose from.
- The title of the video will be highlighted in blue.
- Following the title of the video, you will see a short description of the video.
- Next, you will see the materials that are available with this video. For example, blackline masters, teacher guides, and correlations may be available with some videos.
- Next, you will see the grade level for which this video is appropriate. You will also see the total running time of the video. Next to the running time for the video is the year in which the video was produced.
- Choose which video you wish to view by clicking on the title.

Viewing the video:

- Once you have chosen a video, the video will appear broken into segments.
- Each segment of the movie can be viewed separately. The run time of each segment is in parenthesis behind the title of the segment.
- **S**: The letter S stands for streaming. Streaming will allow you to view the video clip automatically. You would want to stream the video if you just want see if the clip is right for your class. You would not want to always stream video because the video would take up too much bandwidth on the server and cause all of the computers across the parish to run slowly.
- **D**: The letter D stands for download. This is what you want to click on. Once you click on the letter D, you would save the file to your school's network or on the computer hard drive. Once you have saved the video, you can show it to your class.
- **A**: The letter A stands for archive. Archiving is like putting in a bookmark. If you like a video and want to "Bookmark it" for later click on the letter A. Once you click on the letter A, you will have a choice as to where to put your video. You can put it on your play list or you can create a new play list with a new name. You would want to use this feature if you are book marking several videos/clips and you need to organize them.
