

## WBR Virtual Academy Classroom Elementary Expectations

### **General Expectations:**

- Be on time for class each day (sign in virtually 5-10 minutes before the start of class) using your real name-no nicknames.
- Remain in class for the entire class period.
- Dress appropriately for class (school-appropriate attire is required).
- Be fully prepared for class by having your materials ready and accessible before class begins. Materials for each class will be specified by the teacher.
- Charge your computer each night so it is ready for class the next day.
- Some independent work will be required for grades 3-5. This will include Zearn and Imagine Learning.
- Always give your best effort. Assignments will be graded.

### **Virtual Classroom Environment Expectations:**

- Learning should take place in a well-lit area.
- Learning spaces should be free from noise and other distractions.
- Computers should be placed on a flat surface, preferably in an area that allows space for students to work. Some subjects have multiple materials that students will use.
- Chromebook cameras must be on throughout the lesson so students can be observed by and interact with teachers during instructional time.
- No other devices are allowed in the virtual classroom (no cell phones, tablets, video games, etc.) during instructional time.
- Students should not engage in conversations outside of the virtual classroom during instructional time.
- Respect should be given to everyone, by everyone (listen to others, use appropriate language, don't speak when others are speaking, etc.).

### **Expectations for Virtual Classroom Participation:**

- Computer on a flat surface with the camera turned on.
- Raise your hand or use the specified signal to speak.
- Respond to teacher and classmate questions using the designated method of communication (type in the chat bar, write answers on a white board, flash your paper to camera when directed by the teacher, etc.)
- Submit work as directed by the teacher. You may be asked to take a picture of your work, create a flip grid, etc. Digital work such as Zearn lessons and Imagine Learning sessions will be monitored by the teacher.
