How to Make a Payment

Students/Parents/Guardians/Teachers

The school cafeteria has a few simple payment options for you to choose from.

Pay Online: Make an online payment to your child's account using your credit or debit card via www.myschoolbucks.com There is a convenience fee of \$2.49 per transaction.

Pay in Person: Stop by your school cafeteria between the hours of 7 AM to 1 PM Monday thru Friday to pay by cash or check. You may also send cash or check to school with your child. Checks should be made payable to WBR School Foodservice.

Funds should be maintained in accounts to minimize the possibility that a child may be without meal money on any given day. Any remaining funds for a particular student will be carried over to the next school year. For accessing your child account; visit www.myschoolbucks.com (you will need the student's name, date of birth, and school enrolled).

A la carte items or other similar items must be prepaid in advance or paid for at the time of service.

Refunds for withdrawing and graduating students; a written or emailed request for a refund of any money remaining in their account must be submitted. Students who are graduating at the end of the year will be given the option to transfer funds to a sibling's account with a written request.

Application for Free or Reduced Price Meals

The Child Nutrition department will provide parents/guardians with free/reduced price meal applications at the beginning of the school year in school enrollment packets. The free/reduced price meal application can also be found at: <https://www.myschoolapps.com/Application>

The school will provide at least two additional free/reduced price meal applications throughout the school year to families identified as owing meal charges.

Parent Notification of Unpaid Charge Balance

Parents/guardians will be notified that a student has accrued meal charges.

Elementary Students: letters will be handed out to students by their teacher at the end of the day.

Calls, texts or emails on low or delinquent accounts will be sent directly to the parent to try to collect payments.

All delinquent accounts at the beginning of May of the current school year will be subject to collections for payment.

Middle School Students: overdue slips will be sent home with the student whose accounts are a low balance or negative balance.

Calls, texts or emails on low or delinquent accounts will be sent directly to the parent to try to collect payments.

No charges are allowed for extras or a la carte items on any negative account or accounts with a zero balance.

All delinquent accounts at the beginning of May of the current school year will be subject to collections for payment.

If a child has money to purchase a reduced price or full pay meal at the time of the meal service, the child must be provided a meal. SFAs may not use the child's money to repay previously unpaid charges if the child intended to use the money to purchase that day's meal.

High School Students: students will be notified by the food service staff of low or negative balances at the time of checkout.

Calls, texts or emails on low or delinquent accounts will be sent directly to the parent to try to collect payments.

No charges are allowed for extras or a la carte items on any negative account or accounts with a zero balance.

No charging allowed for any high school student beginning April 1st until the end of the year.

All delinquent accounts at the beginning of May of the current school year will be subject to collections for payment.

If a child has money to purchase a reduced price or full pay meal at the time of the meal service, the child must be provided a meal. SFAs may not use the child's money to repay previously unpaid charges if the child intended to use the money to purchase that day's meal.
